- ★ **Friday 6th – 200 Year Commemoration of the Second Settlement**  
Join a local historian for a tour of the World Heritage Listed Convict Kingston area, covering the Polynesian, Convict, and Bounty Mutineer settlements. Visit the museum exhibition on the 2nd Convict settlement and hear convict tales from Norfolk Island's harsh penal colony history. Includes lunch in the Kingston Arthur's Vale Historic Area (KAVHA).
- ★ **Monday 9th Bounty Day Celebration** – Watch the re-enactment of the landing of Norfolk's forbears at Kingston Pier – the Southern Hemisphere's oldest. Follow the procession of the descendants, who will be in their traditional dress, to the Cenotaph to pay respects to fallen heroes and continue to the cemetery for the laying of wreaths on ancestral graves, on to the All Saints Church for the judging of the best dressed families and back through the commons, finishing at the Compound. Observe the tradition of the children rolling down the Government House hill. Before sampling the traditional wetels (food) the Norfolk grace will be sung.
- ★ **A Night on the Bounty Dinner & Show** – A world-famous story performed by a cast of actors and hosted over a 3 course dinner. Get ready for singing, feasting, frivolity and a lot of laughs, as you journey from England to Tahiti with Captain Bligh, Fletcher Christian as the *Bounty* crew.
- ★ **Bounty Folk Museum** – Lose yourself in a museum that is small in size but wide in scope! Pore over artefacts in this Aladdin's Cave of wonders!
